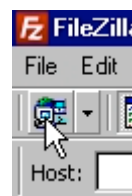
To set up FileZilla for FTP to the Dependable Domains server:

- Open FileZilla from the Desktop icon

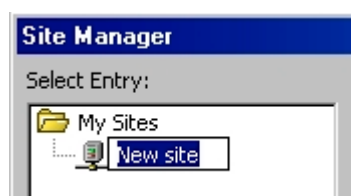
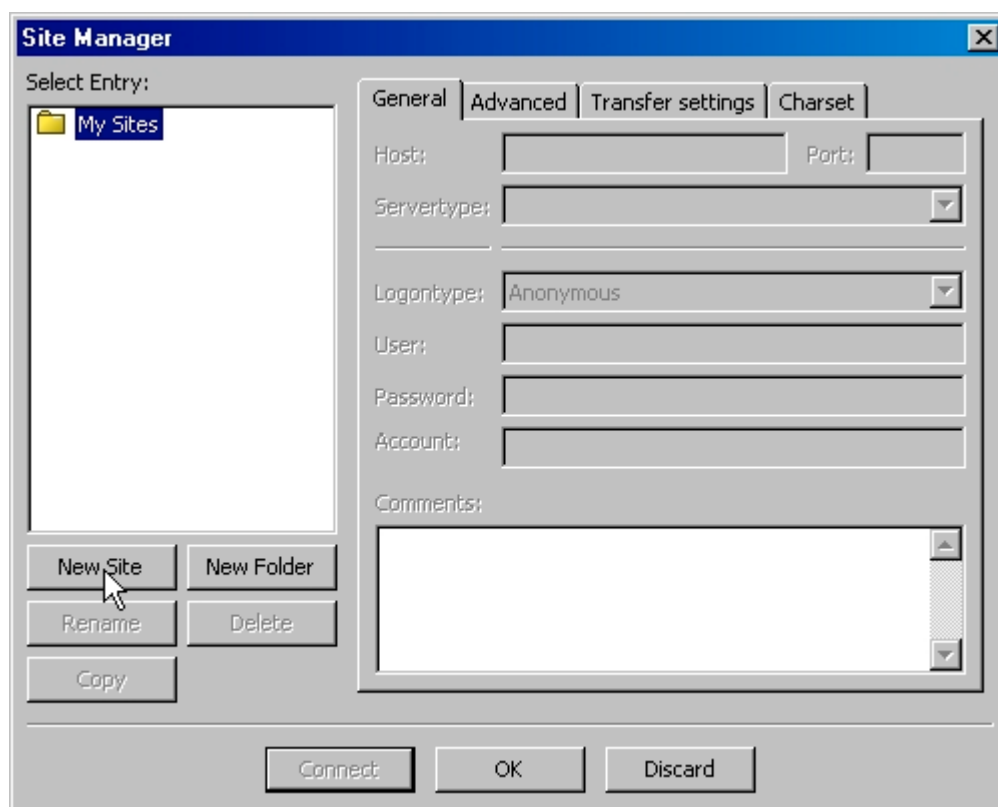


1. Give a name to the FTP connection:

- Open the Site Manager, by clicking on its icon on the toolbar.

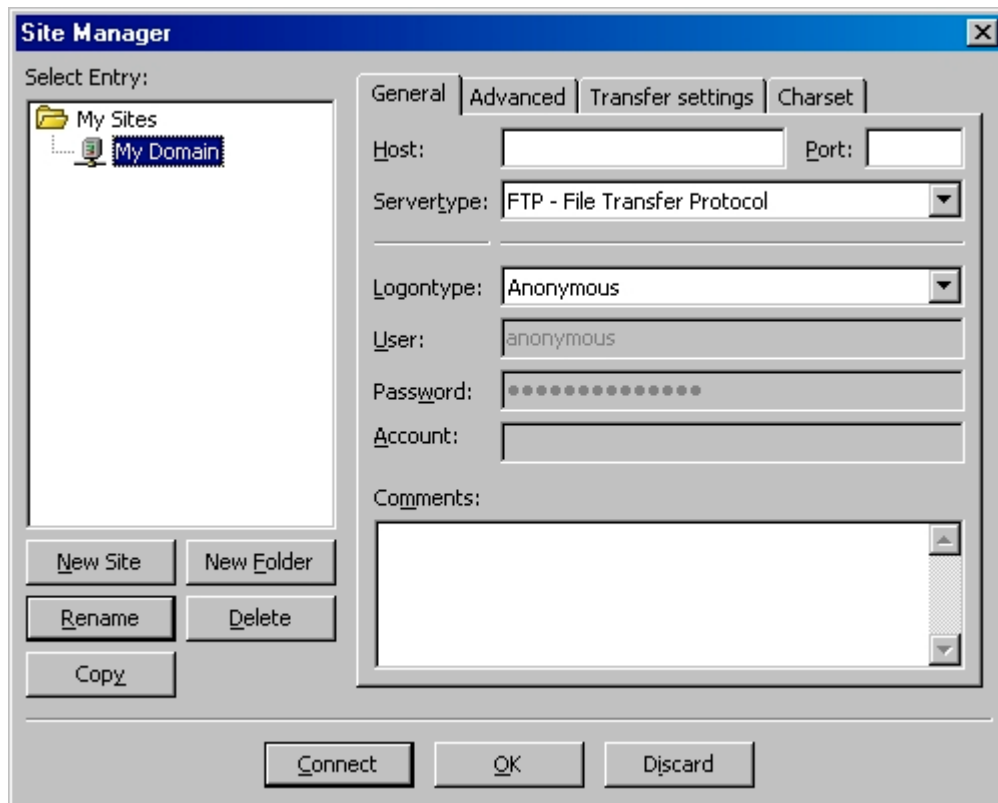


- Click on the "New Site" button.



The name can be anything you choose; eg.

- Enter "My Domain"
- Press the "Enter" key.



2. Enter the information necessary to make an FTP connection:

Server Information

Host: ftp.mydomain (do not include http or www domain prefixes)

Port: leave blank.

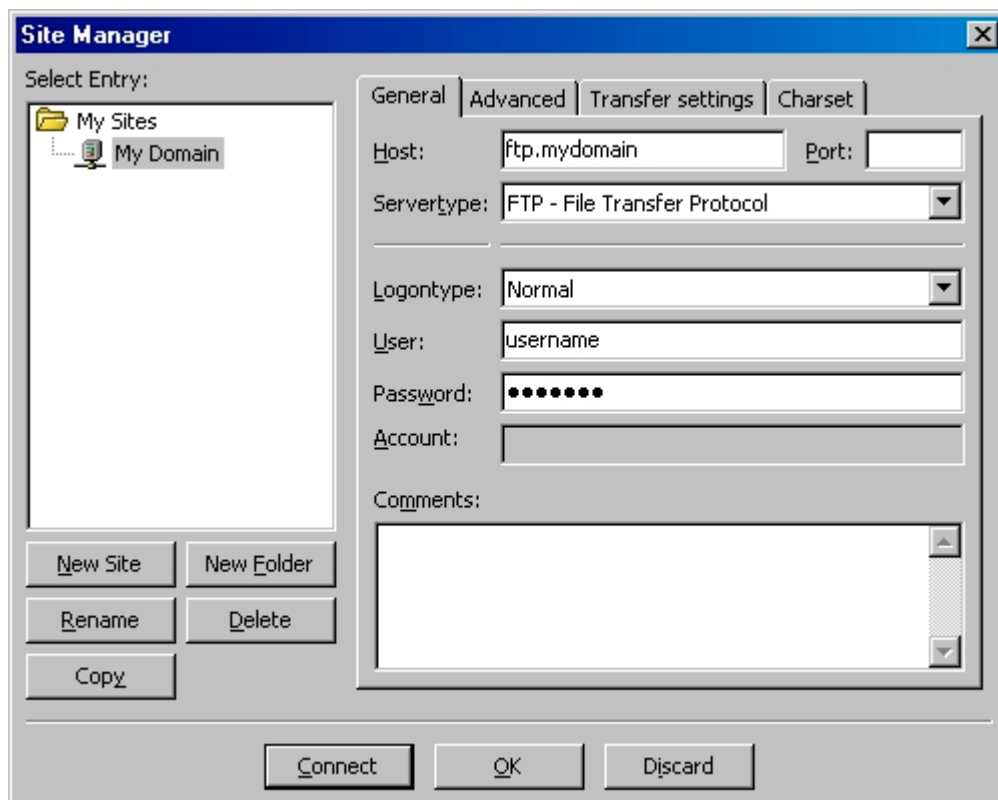
Srvertype: FTP – File Transfer Protocol.

Login Information

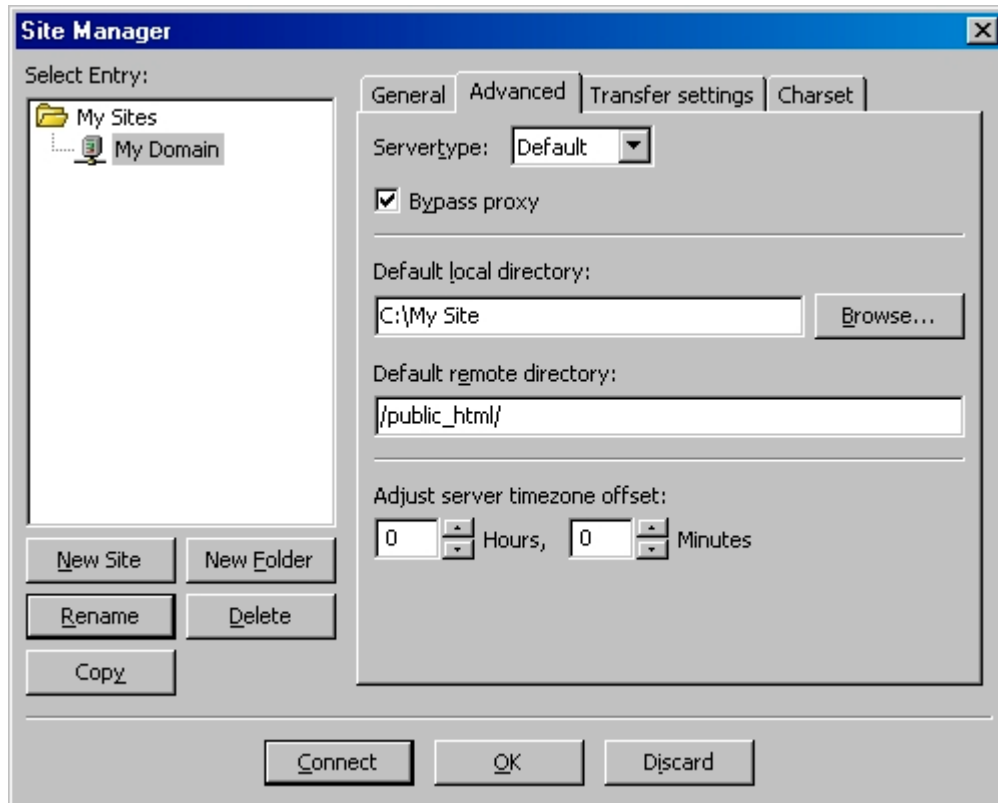
Logontype: Normal.

Username: my hosting account username (from welcome email).

Password: my chosen hosting account password (if changed from that stated in welcome email).



- Click on the “Advanced” tab.



- Tick “Bypass Proxy”

Default local directory:

- Enter the folder on your computer in which your web site files are located.

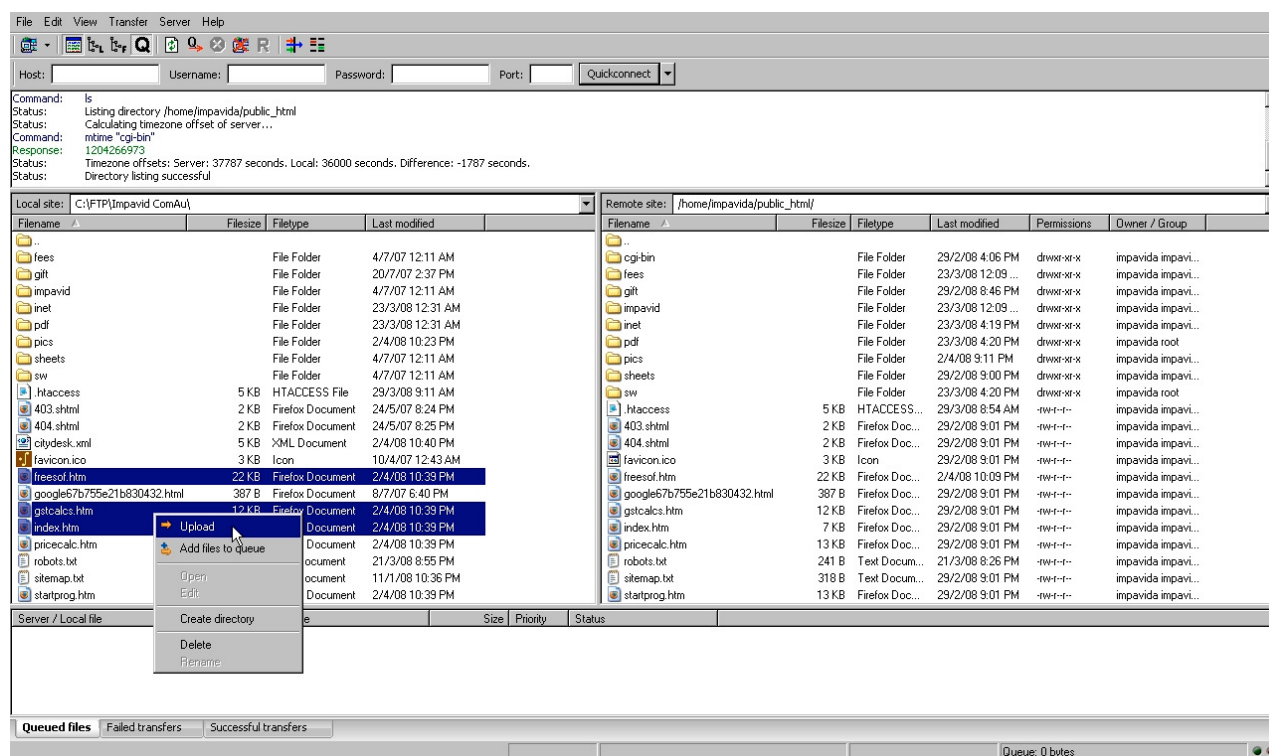
Default remote directory:

- Enter /public_html/

- Click OK.

3. Connect to your web site server using FTP:

- Click on the droplist arrow, just to the right of the Site Manager icon.
- Select the desired FTP connection name.

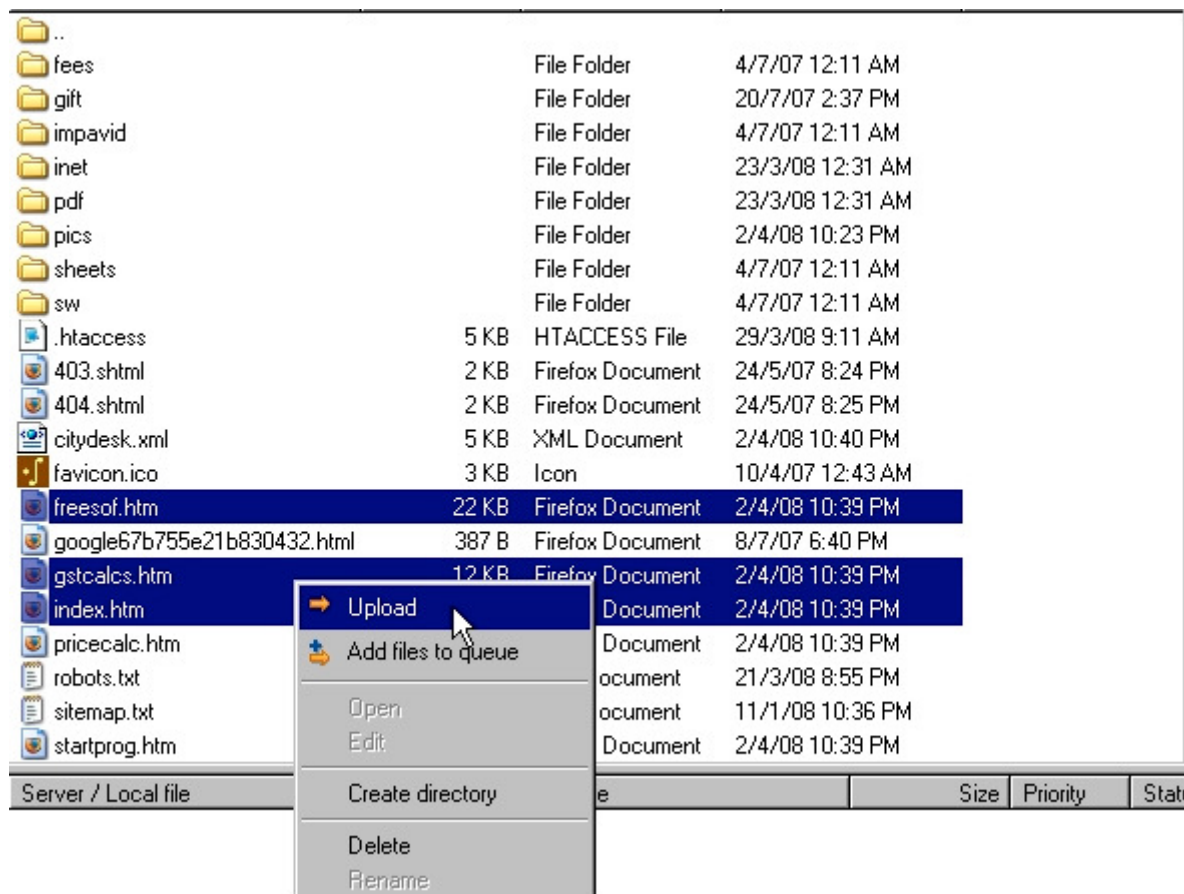


To get rid of the top directory trees that you see in your connection, so that it looks like the screen shot shown above:

- Click on each of the 2 directory tree buttons on the tool bar.



4. Upload files to your web site:



- Select the file or files or folder that you want to upload to the server.
- Click the right mouse button, to get the quick menu.
- Select "Upload".

4. Close the FTP connection:

- Click on the "Disconnect" button on the toolbar.
